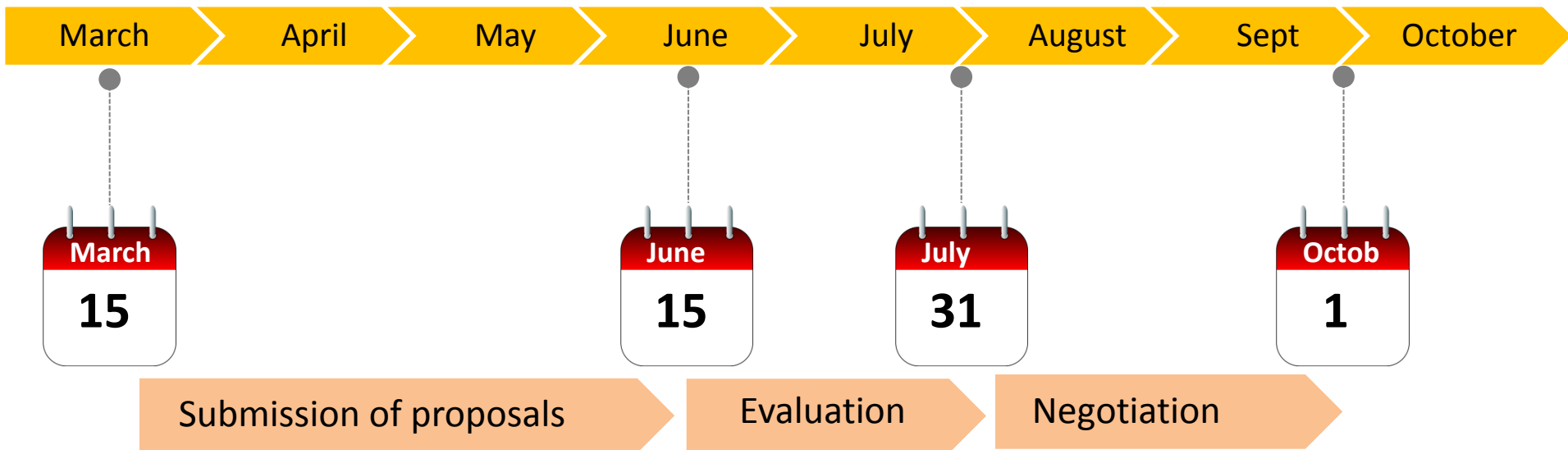

- Funding: up to 60.000 €
- Expected duration of the project: 6 Months
- Start: 15/03/2018
- Deadline: 15/06/2018 (17:00 Brussels time)
- Projects will start: October 2018

- Individual SMEs
- Large companies
- Research Institutes
- Public authorities

A proposal must

- **Integrate** a new IoT infrastructure into VICINITY
- **Co-operate** with the VICINITY partners to demonstrate the open call project's results
- **Explain** how the IoT infrastructure **supports** existing use-cases, services, and/or business models in VICINITY, or new ones, and/or undertake co-creation activities

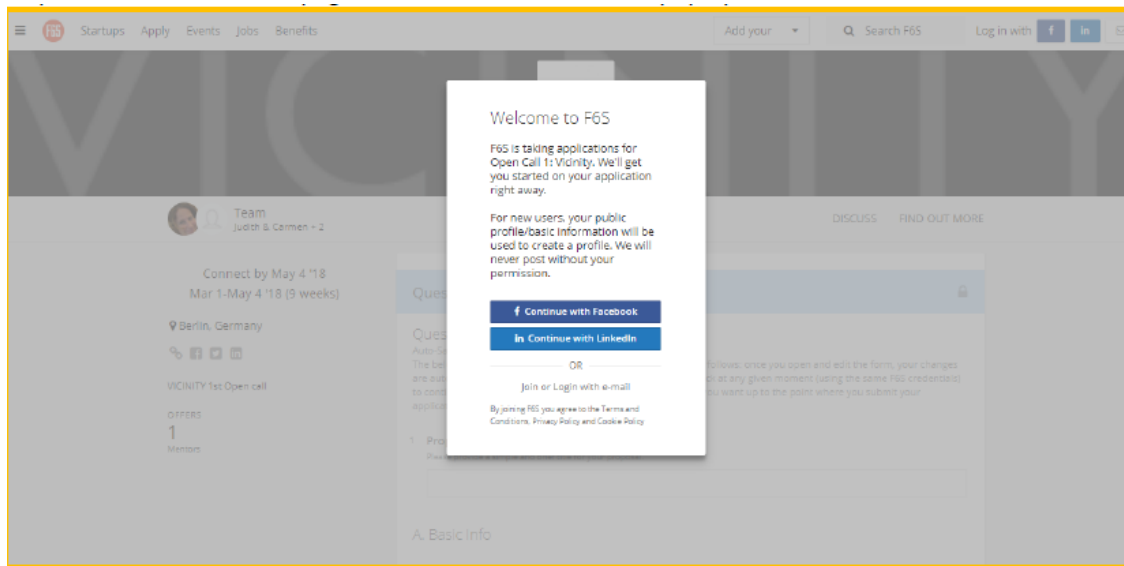

Report

- 40 % Payment in advance after the **signature of the Agreement of collaboration**
- 30% of the overall financial support as interim payment based on the evaluation by the VICINITY consortium of the **Intermediate Report**
- 30% of the overall financial support as Final payment subject to the evaluation by the VICINITY Consortium of the **Final Report**

- Results are **owned** by the Party or by the VICINITY Beneficiary that generates them.
- Joint Result shall be jointly owned by partners in equal shares, unless differently agreed by the Contributors
- Access rights to the Background only if it is needed for the implementation of the extension
